Glia maturation factor-beta (GMF- β) (Murine)

Description:

Glia maturation factor-beta (GMF- β) coded by GMFb gene at chromosome 14 in mouse, is identical to human GMF- β , with the exception of two amino acid residues. It is a brain-specific protein that belongs to the actin-binding proteins (ADF) structural family, and plays an important role in the upstream regulation of excessive production and the releasing of proinflammatory cytokines/chemokines in brain cells, leading to the destruction of oligodendrocytes, the myelin forming cells, and neurons.

Reconstitution:

We recommend that this vial be briefly centrifuged prior to opening to bring the contents to the bottom. Reconstitute in sterile distilled water or aqueous buffer containing 0.1% BSA to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/mL. Stock solutions should be apportioned into working aliquots and stored at $< -20^{\circ}\text{C}$. Further dilutions should be made in appropriate buffered solutions.

Formulation:

Lyophilized from a 0.2 μm filtered concentrated solution in PBS, pH 7.4.

Storage:

This lyophilized preparation is stable at 2-8 $^{\circ}\text{C}$, but should be kept at -20 $^{\circ}\text{C}$ for long term storage, preferably desiccated. Upon reconstitution, the preparation is stable for up to one week at 2-8 $^{\circ}\text{C}$. For maximal stability, apportion the reconstituted preparation into working aliquots and store at -20 $^{\circ}\text{C}$ to -70 $^{\circ}\text{C}$. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.

Molecular Weight:

Approximately 16.4 kDa, a single non-glycosylated polypeptide chain containing 141

amino acid residues.

Endotoxin:

Less than 1 EU/ μ g of GMF- β as determined by LAL method.
