Macrophage-Derived Chemokine/CCL22 (MDC/CCL22) (Human)

Description:

Macrophage-Derived Chemokine/CCL22 (MDC) is a CC chemokine that is produced in B cells, macrophages, monocyte-derived dendritic cells, activated NK cells and CD4 T cells. It signals through the CCR4 receptor. MDC chemoattracts monocytes, dendritic cells and NK cells and exerts HIV suppressive activity.

Source:

Escherichia coli

Reconstitution:

We recommend that this vial be briefly centrifuged prior to opening to bring the contents to the bottom. Reconstitute in sterile distilled water or aqueous buffer containing 0.1% BSA to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/mL. Stock solutions should be apportioned into working aliquots and stored at < -20°C. Further dilutions should be made in appropriate buffered solutions.

Formulation:

Lyophilized from a 0.2 µm filtered concentrated solution in 20 mM PB, pH7.4, 500 mM NaCl.

Storage:

This lyophilized preparation is stable at 2-8°C, but should be kept at -20°C for long term storage, preferably desiccated. Upon reconstitution, the preparation is stable for up to one week at 2-8°C. For maximal stability, apportion the reconstituted preparation into working aliquots and store at -20°C to -70°C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.

Molecular Weight:

Approximately 8.1 kDa, a single, non-glycosylated polypeptide chain containing 69 amino acids.

Endotoxin:

Less than 1 EU/ μ g of MDC/CCL22 as determined by LAL method.

Usage:

Biological Activity:

The biologically active determined by a chemotaxis bioassay using human T-lymphocytes is in a concentration range of 10-100 ng/mL.

Sterile filtered white lyophilized (freeze-dried) powder.
